We are excited to inform you that the school-based health program has added Prisma Health (formerly Palmetto Health) as a provider in the program. Other providers include those from the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC) Health.

As a reminder, your student has the opportunity to be examined, diagnosed, and treated by a nurse practitioner or doctor from **Prisma Health** or **MUSC Health** while at school via telemedicine. Advantages of the program include reduced missed class time for students and reduced missed work for parents.

Please contact your school nurse to confirm that your student is enrolled or if you would like to enroll your student in the program.


